As of March 2005, the database covers 10,980 magazine titles out of 13,800 included in the Prange Collection, originally belonged to the Civil Censorship Detachment, a unit within GHQ, which covers a wide range of subjects: politics, economics, sociology, education, history, philosophy, religion, art, language, literature, etc.	The database provides an author index to a print publication <i>Meiji, Taishō, Shōwa zenki zasshi kiji sakuin shūsei</i> , which reproduces various periodical indexes originally published during the Meiji (1868-1912) through 1948, covering humanities and social sciences, as well as specialized areas such as hygiene, urban problems, and youths and women labors.
