PURPOSE

Some Japanese databases provide an English interface option with an English search capability. However, the search results between Japanese and English searches may vary. This does not necessarily mean that the Japanese search is always better than the English "equivalent" search. In this session, the students in pairs will experiment with searches in both English and Japanese on the same topic, and compare the search results.
